Focused ultrasound is a platform technology that has the potential to transform the treatment of a variety of medical conditions. There are currently 34 focused ultrasound indications in various stages of development in the UK and more than 170 around the world, including Alzheimer's disease, Parkinson's disease, metastatic breast tumours, and tumours of the brain, liver, pancreas, and prostate. The treatment for both prostate cancer and essential tremor has <u>National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE)</u> approval and <u>National Health Service England (NHS) coverage</u>. The (UK FUSF) is an independent charity dedicated to advancing the development and adoption of focused ultrasound in the UK; it is registered with the Charity Commission and HMRC, and GiftAid Eligible. UK FUSF works closely with, but is independent of, the US-based Focused Ultrasound Foundation, aligning on goals and resources to advance focused ultrasound to treat millions worldwide.
